

ABSTRACT

Poverty is complex and multidimensional problems. Therefore, to reduce poverty must be comprehensive, there are several aspects of community life, and implemented in an integrated manner. Poverty alleviation will be one important indicator of the success of the development country. This research aims to know how the influence of Gross Regional Domestic Product (GDP), Human Development Index (HDI), the Provincial Minimum Wage and inflation to the number of poor population in district of Lampung province. The approach method used in this research is panel data, and multiple regression analysis with Models Random Efek.

The result is (1) Human Development Index gives negative and significant effect on the number of poor population. (2) The Provincial Minimum Wage gives negative and significant effect on the number of poor population. (3) Gross Regional Domestic Product gives positive and significant effect on the number of poor population. (4) and inflation gives no effect on the number of poor population in district of Lampung province.
