

CHAPTER THREE

RESEARCH METHODS

A. Type of Research

The type of this research is normative legal research. Normative legal research is research based on the library research, focusing on reading and analysis of the primary and secondary materials. The researcher collected the data from library in order to find the regulation and theory related to the object of research.¹ This normative legal research is a research procedure to find fact based on legal scientific logic in term of its normative.² This research also applied statute approach which elaborates regulation, namely The National Dispute Resolution Chamber (NDRC) Standard Regulation.³

B. Type of Data

This legal research used sources of data taken from literatures. Data used in this research consisted of primary data, secondary data and tertiary data. This legal material consists of:⁴

- b) Law No. 5 Year 2005 on National Sporting System
 - c) Law No. 30 Year 1999 on Arbitration and Alternative Dispute Resolution
 - d) FIFA Regulation on Status and Transfer Players
 - e) FIFA National Dispute Resolution Chamber (NDRC) Standard Regulations
 - f) PSSI Regulation on Status and Transfer Players
2. Secondary legal material consisted of documents related to the primary legal material such as:
- a) Books;
 - b) Scientific Journals;
 - c) Reliable sources form internets;
 - d) Other documents related to this research.
3. Tertiary legal material consisted of documents such as dictionary and encyclopedia.

C. Data Collection

The data were collected through analyzing literatures and reading related documents such as regulations, books, scientific journals, and others which related to the object of this research.

D. Data Analysis

The data in this research were analyzed through descriptive qualitative.
