

CHAPTER IV GENERAL DESCRIPTION OF OBJECTS

A. Gilangharjo Profile

Gilangharjo village is generally a village with a rice typology. As for some dukuhs, they do have clay types, but in general they are still productive for agriculture and gardening. Gilangharjo is one of the villages in Pandak Subdistrict, Bantul, Special Region of Yogyakarta, Indonesia. This village has an area of ± 726 hectares, consisting of 15 hamlets and 91 RT. The population of Gilangharjo Village in 2017 was 17025 people consisting of 5,500 families. Organic rice plants are one of the mainstays in the village of Gilangharjo, the results of which are very good, at this time also in the context of the development of both organic rice and organic fertilizer, which initially only 60 people increased to 70 people. The harvest is packed with 5 kg packaging according to the order from outside. North of the Ringinharjo village, south of Sidomulyo village, west side village Rriharjo, east side desa Sumbermulyo.

Pandak District is in the lowlands. The subdistrict capital is at an altitude of 27 meters above sea level. The distance of the District Capital to the Government Center (Capital) of the Bantul Regency is 5 Km. The stretch of area in Pandak Subdistrict is quite varied, 90% of the area is flat to wavy and another 10% is wavy to hilly. Pandak sub-district has a climate like a lowland area in the tropics with hot weather as its trademark. The highest temperature recorded in Pandak Subdistrict is 32°C with the lowest temperature of 20°C, And most of the population in Pandak District are

farmers. From the District monograph data there were 15,664 people or 32.5% of the total population working in the agricultural sector.

Gilangharjo consists of 15 hamlets and 91 RT. The fifteen hamlets included: Kadisoro Hamlet, Jodog Hamlet, Karangasem Hamlet, Daleman Hamlet, Jomboran Hamlet, Kauman Hamlet, Kadekrowo Hamlet, Bongsren Hamlet, Ngaran Hamlet,

Karanggede Hamlet, Gunting Hamlet, Depok Hamlet, Tegallurung Hamlet, Banjarwaru Hamlet, and Hamlet Krekah. The population of Gilangharjo Village in 2009 was 16,390 people consisting of 4,653 households.

People in Gilangharjo, if they want to do economic, health or other activities to Pandak Subdistrict, have a distance of 2 km from their village. The trip can take around 4-5 minutes to reach the center of the capital city of Pandak District. Whereas to get to the capital of Bantul Regency, it has a distance of 5 km or can be reached in 10 minutes.

The village of Gilangharjo, which is preparing itself to become a tourist village, has various tourism potentials that are worthy of being compared to other tourist villages. The tourism potential includes culinary, home industry, handicrafts, historical sites, art, culture and attractive rural landscape. Art potentials in Gilangharjo include painting, mask art, batik art, dance, sculpture, karaoke and music.
