Hospital plays a key role in national health care system. Management functions are described as planning, organizing, actuating and controlling (monitoring) function. As a hospital operates under 5 years makes it a suitable subject to improving nursing performance evaluation. The purpose of these researches is to determine the role to developing market. The purpose of these researches is to determine the efficiency and effectiveness of planning and controlling management on improving nursing performance. Qualitative investigation has been conducted in this study using analytic descriptive method through debriefing and observation. Respondents chosen were fixed as manager's chief and primary nurse. The results showed lack of communication and training (<20 hrs per year), periodic supervision and also lack of the amount of nurse, orderly job description allocation and poor performance measurement. Another factors were found such as the lack of continuity in nurse education and administration due to performance. These results are hoped to give information and admonition of how far management control can affect the performance of a hospital and thus describe relationship between factors for better understanding on management health care systems. Therefore, management planning and control functions have a key role in improving nurse's performance.
