# CHAPTER V

## CONCLUSIONS

This chapter is divided into two parts, namely conclusion and suggestion. In the first part, the researcher presents the conclusion of the research on students' perception on the use of mind mapping technique in reading, the strengths and weaknesses on the use of the mind mapping technique in reading. The second part, the researcher provides some suggestions which are related to the research.

#### A. Conclusion

In conclusion, based on the responses from the participants, there was some problem when the students read namely: vocabularies, meaning, and main points. Then, the participants also mentioned the strategies in reading as follow: skimming, scanning and mind mapping. In addition, there were four perceptions on the use of the mind mapping technique in reading. First, mind mapping eases students' in reading.
